- Catholic High School Placement Test Registration form and the \$25.00 test fee
- Transcript Release Form

CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL PLACEMENT TEST NOVEMBER 14, 2009

In order to be considered for admission to Mater Dei, you must take this placement test and you must have a completed application on file at Mater Dei.

The placement test is given at several locations throughout Monmouth County, including Mater Dei High School, at 8:00 a.m. on November 14, 2009.

Students planning on attending Catholic High School may take this test at any location approved by the Diocese of Trenton. It is used primarily to determine freshman year course level placement for the incoming student and is not a test of eligibility for admission to any Catholic high school.

Please plan to take the test at Mater Dei and indicate Mater Dei High School as your first choice when you register for the test. Please note that admissions preference is given to students who test at Mater Dei.

FINANCIAL AID FILING DEADLINE FEBRUARY 26, 2010
